6-9 months Puppy Dog

1. #515 – Cawarra's Old Time Rock N Roll -  
Chocolate baby, with soft expression, just right  
for his age, good length of neck, level topline,  
nice tight feet, moved well and with confidence,  
good angles front and rear, will be nice to see  
him when he matures.

Best Puppy

2. #525 – Labradale’s Winning Streak – Happy black puppy, also right for his age, nice head and soft expression, good length of neck, topline a little soft as he is growing, nice forechest, good bone and feet. Moved with reach and drive, will be nice to see him when he matures.

#### 12-15 month Dog

1. #529 – Labradale's Big Whiskey – Strong yellow boy, nice outline, wasn’t sure why he was there, but showed and moved very well, masculine head, not overdone, kind expression, good length of neck, level topline, good bone and feet, with more ring experience he should do quite well.

#### Canadian Bred Dog

1. #411 – Oaksill Smooth Criminal – Yellow boy, moved out well with level topline, good tailset, still young, should mature nicely.

## Open Chocolate Dog

1. #317 – Fargoridge Lastcall Seaworthy - Nice boy with great qualities, strong and powerful, but not overdone, head and expression kind and soft, good length of neck, well placed shoulders, level topline with good tailset, correct coat, nice dark chocolate, everything in the right place, one to be proud of.

## Open Black Dog

1. #357 – Jaunenoir Masonridge P Bunyan – Good size boy, would like to have seen a better head, he was a bit shy upon examination, he was better on the movement, he just needs more exposure and hopefully will be more comfortable in the ring.
2. #521 – Castilleja's Edsel Citation – Mature in good coat, unfortunately shy upon examination, hard to describe the expression and movement. He needs more exposure.

## Open Yellow Dog

1. #191 – Whitevelvet Feel the Sand – He was shy upon examination, hard to do a proper critique, he needs more experience, needs to mature.

## Veteran Dog 9 years and over

1. #531 – GCH Nyroca Castlegar Remember MII – Lovely black in good condition, excellent coat and tail, good topline and tailset, moved out well.

## 6-9 months puppy Bitches

1. #632 – Castillejas Lets Dance – Sweet chocolate, first time in the ring, did quite well, feminine head and expression, good length of neck, moved out well.
2. #634 – Labradale's Rising Sun - Yellow baby, enjoying her time in the ring, would like to have

seen a better head and expression, could change with maturity, forechest is good, moved out nicely.

#### 9-12 months puppy Bitch

1. #412 – Samphire Vivacious – Chocolate with nice outline, good body and coat, well angulated, moved well, would have liked a bit darker eye color.

#### 12-15 months Bitches

1. #626 – Amaizeing Grace at Devonsleigh - Head needs to mature, good bone and feet, nice outline, good coat and tail, moved out well.
2. #378 – Wyndance's Here Comes Da' Judd – Not as balanced as first place, a little rounder eye than I like, tailset a bit low, moved ok.

#### 15-18 months Bitches

1. #138 – Castillega's Kelsey at Fullcount – Black girl, not in her best coat today, feminine head with soft

expression, nice outline, could have a little more bone, moved out well.

2. #650 – Castillega's Dutchie – Yellow girl, would have liked to see a softer expression, low tailset and soft on the topline, needs to mature.

#### Bred By Exhibitor Bitch

1. #614 – Staghorn's Load of Malarkey – Black girl in excellent condition, good coat and tail, topline and tailset are good, good bone and feet, made her handler work on the move.

1. #536 – Pirates Queen of the Night - Lovely feminine girl, soft expression, good length of neck, well placed shoulders, level topline and tailset, good forechest and well angulated front and rear, moved out very well, she was missing coat, but could not deny her the win.

2. #588 – Gorsebrook Solaia Blairour – Outline could have been better, would have liked more stop, eye color could be better, low tailset.
